

Steven Ashe was born in 1960, Exeter in Gloucestershire, England and has been actively involved in the literary and practical Qabalah since 1978. He has an B.A. (Hons) Degree in Interactive Multimedia Communications. In addition to his list of published works, including articles for Practitioner Magazine, Pan Sophia, Thelemic Magic (Victorians 1 & 2), Mandala of Colours (1984, 1989) he has produced a series of Audio CDs upon the modern approach of the Hermetic Qabalah.

His published works include The Testament of Solomon, the monumental Complete Golden Dawn Initiate and the audio lecture CDs The Alchemical Qabalah and The Qabalah: The Book of Carl's from the same publisher. These are included on the 3 1/2 hour audio DVD of teaching materials which accompany The Complete Golden Dawn Initiate - available from www.lulu.com/Qabalah

In addition to his production of an audio CD recording of Aleister Crowley's The Book of the Law Steven has advised upon the additional oversight of *The Phoenix* - the crest of all magical practices which informed the publication of Crowley's Magick, Perceptions and Francis Bacon - reproduced in the original Audio as a luxury information item for the various collector of arcane manuscripts. His first published full length work upon advanced Qabalahic lore *Qabalah of 50 Gates* is considered to be one of the most exciting experimental works of Qabalahic philosophy in the English language.
