Five Little Piggies , David Martin, Jan 1, 1998, Family & Relationships, 34 pages. The lines of a familiar nursery rhyme are expanded into stories about the activities of a family of pigs.

The great cheese conspiracy, Jean Van Leeuwen, 1969, , 87 pages. Tired of gangster movies and a steady diet of candy wrappers, three theater mice try to rob a cheese shop..
