Don't believe the negative reviews... If you pass on this edition, you will truly miss out on a fantastic translation of *Mein Kampf*! I have read the 1943 Manheim translation, the 1939 Murphy translation, the 1939 Reynal & Hitchcock translation and the 2009 Ford translation. All have their own particular merits, and all appeal to certain audiences. The Manheim appeals to the scholarly and is indeed a faithful, word-for-word translation of *Mein Kampf*. However, it is incomplete. Further, following it in places can be very confusing in the English language, and many people I know have simply put it down in frustration. It's obviously a scholar's edition, as the German-language footnotes attest. The Reynal & Hitchcock edition is a better flowing edition than the Manheim, in my opinion, but has been out of print since 1943, when the Manheim was published by Houghton-Mifflin. Why? Because Houghton-Mifflin did not want to pay royalties to Reynal & Hitchcock for their translation, so Ralph Manheim was commissioned for a new translation, which is, in fact, clumsier than the original. The Murphy edition is far shorter, a fairly easy read for those who speak/read British English and have a decent vocabulary. However, it is paraphrased - as Murphy read a paragraph and put it into his own words. Not Hitler's words, but in most places, true to the meaning. But in some places, he misses the point (as Ford's book about the *MEIN KAMPF* translation controversy points out). So if you want Hitler, you won't get it from Murphy... Onto Ford's translation... The thing I like about this translation is that it strikes me as a true *PEOPLE'S EDITION* of *Mein Kampf*. It is *COMPLETE* and *TRUE* to the original, but being a *PEOPLE'S EDITION* does *NOT* mean that it is dumbed-down. It simply means it is readable, flows well and keeps the reader's interest throughout. *EVERY READER'S INTEREST*. And that was exactly what the author, Adolf Hitler, wanted. He wanted *EVERYONE* in his country to read his book. Not just the university professor. It wasn't for the elite few. It was for the bus driver, the soldier, the unemployed - it made no difference! It was for everyone. In German, it flowed (and still flows) fine. But when translated to English, it doesn't flow so well, as various translations prove. However, with the Ford translation, it flows *VERY WELL*. It has been restored to its former status and is once again for *EVERYONE*. Couple this with Ford's explanatory notes in the text as well as his added 27 pages of pictures that show key people and places mentioned by Hitler, and this makes an edition of *Mein Kampf* that has yet to be beaten. I signed up for a local college class in art, nothing to do with history. But when I was touring the campus bookstore I found this little book. I checked my iPhone to compare prices and amazon was cheaper than the bookstore so I ordered from amazon instead. I had to order because after looking at this book it was clear there was something missing from my WWII history knowledge. I have always been a history buff and loved anything to do with WWII, but somehow I never read Hitler's own book. I guess I always assumed it was a hate filled rant and not worth reading. I now know that it is very much worth reading and this edition is especially worth reading. This edition includes a lengthy introduction which includes a teacher's guide. Of course, it was written for the classroom, and it also has a student guide which gives a summary and explanation of *Mein Kampf* plus explains a lot about Hitler. Then there is the main introduction which explains even more history and explains the history of the translations of *Mein Kampf*. All fascinating and I had not even made it to the actual text of the book. When I finished reading all the background, I was given a link to a supplement file that had even more information on *Mein Kampf*, the history behind it, when/where/how it was written, some inside secrets behind Hitler's writing style, and corrections that were made to this edition plus parts that were restored. Now, finally I can return to this book from the file and start actually reading *Mein Kampf*. It was great! I learned a lot about the times and Weimar that I never

knew before. It is funny how they don't tell you everything in history books. This edition also includes notes right in the text which explain things I would not have known. It is very nice because I might be lazy and not look up a person or place, and even if I did I would get a general description. The notes in this book are clearly aimed at students because they explain people along with their relevance to the area where they are mentioned, not just a generic description. It is obvious a lot of research went into this book. I am glad I found it and it is a great book even if you are not a college student but just a student of WWII. Read more &rsaquo;

I will focus my review on the translation and edition rather than the book itself - if you want a thorough review of the book, go there:[...]As to this edition, it has an excellent translation. Apart from a number of minor flaws (which will be corrected in the next edition, since I actually sent the publishers a list of said flaw, and was told they'd be taken in account), the text is extremely readable. On top of that excellent translation are notes; not footnotes or endnotes, but italicised parentheses which clear up references or explain context, or gives the reader whatever he may not know (anything from historical facts to myth references to expressions, puns, Hitler's entourage, etc.). The most recent edition of Mein Kampf, recommended.

I had always wanted to read this book ever since high school, but as I have grown older and have a deeper understanding on how things work in the world it became important for me to read this book to understand a lot of Hitler's mind and thoughts were during his rise to power. This is a good read, sometimes a little hard to understand, but has historical value and for us that appreciate that kind of stuff- it is important.

This is not what you likely expect. The book itself is very interesting especially if you like history. Hitler spends most of the book discussing his childhood, his views on people, politicians he believed were destroying Germany, and explaining how he (single handedly by his account) built the Nazi party. He really makes you think about your own opinions and where they come from. You will find yourself agreeing with him in some areas without realizing why (so it gives you food for thought). It is a great behind the scenes revelation of the Nazi party too. On the translation itself, this is an excellent translation which is easy to read and includes historical notations that explain the text. The introduction also explains the history of the book. There is even a separate book that goes with this one which explains how this one was translated and is filled with examples which show clearly that this one is more accurate than other translations plus it too has even more history and a discussion of Hitler's writing style. Well worth reading.
